SUNDAY MORNING WORSHIP: Again, the building will not be open to worshippers. Similar to Wednesday Lenten worship, a small group and I will lead worship that will be available on Facebook Live or the radio broadcast at 9:30 a.m. on WMEQ AM880. My hope is we will be able once again to gather together on April 5, Palm Sunday. We will keep you updated.

All other meetings and gatherings are put on hold.

Concerning home, nursing home, and hospital visits, our home communion ministers and I are "on lock-down" as well. Phone calls will be used to keep in touch, and we suggest that all of our members use phone calls to stay connected to their family, friends, and church family. We need a strong sense of community right now, and since we cannot meet face-to-face, we must find alternate ways to care and support one another.

Under these circumstances, we are learning how to be church together in a different way for a while. For now, almost everything has changed. The one thing that hasn't changed is God's love for us. It is imperative to remember our mission: Love Jesus, Grow Together, Serve Others.

Finally, the better we comply with these difficult expectations, the sooner we can gather to worship, continue our ministries, and use our building.
