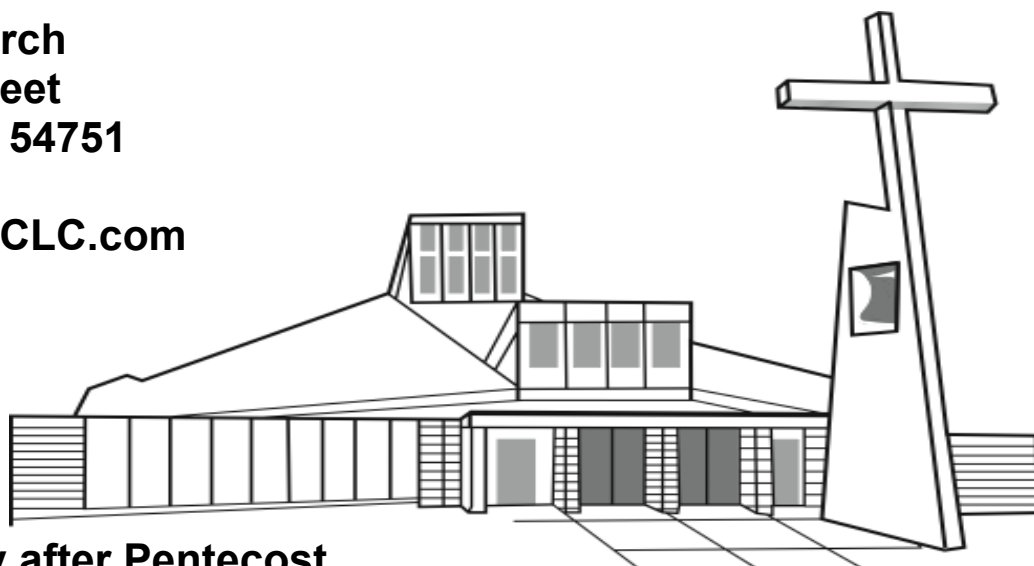

Fort McCoy Afghan Resettlement needs

There may be up to 10,000 Afghan refugees arriving at Fort McCoy for resettlement across the country. This is a huge humanitarian effort. Menomonie area churches are joining others and helping by collecting clothing, household supplies, money, and other items to help transition families to life in the U.S. The Menomonie Area Ministerial Association (of which CLC is a member) is working out details for collecting and delivering these items. Meanwhile, you can help by starting to collect items of immediate need; details of where to take the items will follow.
